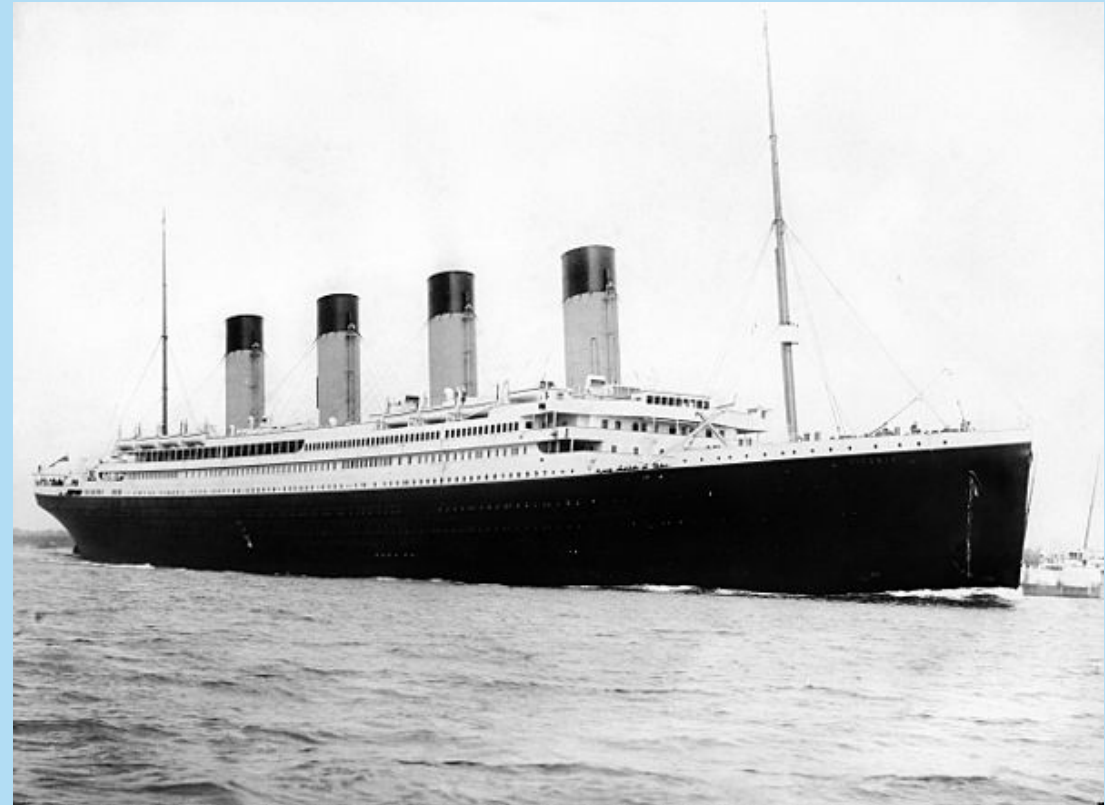

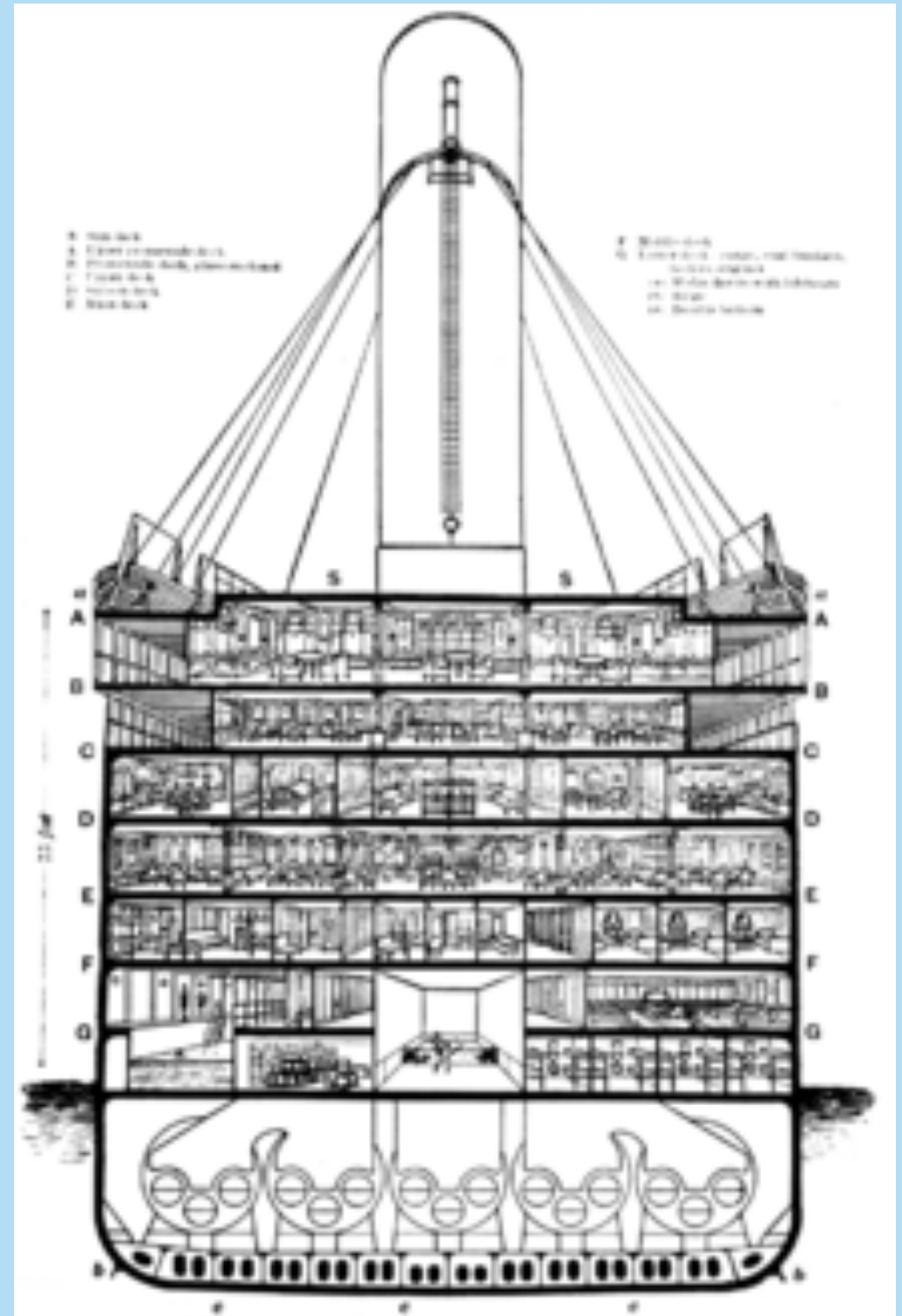

**THE TITANIC SINKS WITH 1,800 ON BOARD; ONLY 675, MOSTLY WOMEN AND CHILDREN, SAVED**

REARMS OF THE BOARD, ARRANGED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF THE NAVY.

**MOST APPALLING DISASTER IN MARINE HISTORY OCCURS WHEN WORLD'S LARGEST STEAMSHIP STRIKES GIANTIC ICEBERG AT NIGHT**

Scores of World's Most Widely Known Persons, Including Colonel John Jacob Astor and His Wife, William T. Stead and Isidor Straus Among Those Whose Fate Is in Doubt.

J. Bruce Ismay, Head of the White Star Line; Mr. and Mrs. George D. Widener, the Countess of Rothes and Mrs. Henry D. Harris Are Some of Those Saved.

In the darkness of night and in winter the White Star Line's Titanic, second of the White Star line and greatest of all ocean steamships, sank on her maiden voyage to New York from Southampton, England, on Tuesday night, April 14, 1912, after striking a giant iceberg in the North Atlantic Ocean.

Dispatch received late last night from the Cape Race Wireless station in Newfoundland and elsewhere immediately made it the news item by the New York Herald of the White Star Company's largest and finest ship, the Titanic, which was on her maiden voyage to New York from Southampton, England, on Tuesday night, April 14, 1912, after striking a giant iceberg in the North Atlantic Ocean.

Should there prove to be any survivors, the fate of the Titanic, which, according to reports, was the greatest of all ocean steamships, is a matter of great interest to the public.

A dispatch from St. John, N. B., received at Cape Race yesterday afternoon, which, according to reports, was the first news of the disaster, stated that the Titanic had struck an iceberg on Tuesday night, April 14, 1912, and was sinking rapidly. The survivors were taken to the hospital at Cape Race, where they were treated for their injuries.
